

## **Rt Hon Lord Justice Scott Baker**

Lord Justice Scott Baker was called to the Bar (Middle Temple) in 1961. He was appointed as a Recorder in 1976 and remained one until 1988 when he was appointed as a High Court Judge in the Family Division (1988-92), and then transferred to the Queen's Bench Division in 1992. In 1978 he was appointed as a Queen's Counsel. He became a Lord Justice of Appeal in 2002. He was a member of the Government Committee of Inquiry into Human Fertilisation (the Warnock Committee) 1982-84 and a member of the Parole Board 1999-2002. He sat as coroner for the inquests into the deaths of Diana, Princess of Wales and Dodi Fayed in 2007 and 2008. He was made an Honorary Fellow of Brasenose College, Oxford in 2003.
